

City of Redmond PROCLAMATION

A proclamation designating the first Friday of October as **NATIONAL MANUFACTURING DAY**

WHEREAS, the first Friday of October each year is designated as National Manufacturing Day; and

WHEREAS, manufacturing makes a very significant contribution to the national, state, and local economy; and

WHEREAS, Redmond is a significant contributor to the manufacturing industry in our region and is fortunate to be the home of many world-class and diverse manufacturing companies; and

WHEREAS, Redmond serves as the region's manufacturing hub and accounts for over 1,450 jobs within the city as of 2017. Over one quarter of the Deschutes County manufacturing jobs are located in Redmond. Redmond's employment in the manufacturing sector expanded by 77 percent from 2010-2017, while real total wages paid in the sector grew by a remarkable 79 percent; and

WHEREAS, the manufacturing companies located in Redmond add to the vitality and prosperity of our community by providing high paying quality jobs; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council of the City of Redmond, Oregon, hereby proclaims the first Friday of October to be **NATIONAL MANUFACTURING DAY**. For 2019, National Manufacturing Day is hereby designated as October 4, 2019. The City Council hereby urges all citizens to join in recognizing the value of our manufacturers and the importance they serve in our community.
